Michael P. Veglia, 89, passed away early in the morning on August 14, 2022.

Michael was the son of the late Louis Veglia and Frances (Palumbo) Veglia. He was born on June 29, 1933 in Chicago, Illinois. He was the second of the couple's four sons.

Michael graduated from Austin High School in Chicago where he won many awards for playing the trombone. A veteran, he served in the US Army from 1953 – 1955. Upon returning from his Army Service, he attended Logan College of Chiropractic in Saint Louis, MO where he earned his Doctor of Chiropractic degree. He operated his own Chiropractic practice for 30 years, mainly in Illinois. Michael was a long-time member of the Rotary Club in Illinois. He retired to Florida 2008.

In addition to his career, Michael was passionate about the Fine Arts, especially Opera, Painting and Cooking. Michael was preceded in death by his brother Jerry Veglia and sister-in-law Anne Veglia.

The example he set impacted not only his family, but his friends and all those he encountered throughout his life.
