Morton Edward Aronson, 88, passed away peacefully on September 29, 2022, at Manatee Memorial Hospital.

Born in Chicago, Illinois on January 5, 1934, he was the son of Carl and Tillie Aronson. He graduated from Roosevelt University with a degree in Philosophy. He was employed by the Social Security Administration for forty years, retiring as a Security Analyst at the Regional Office.

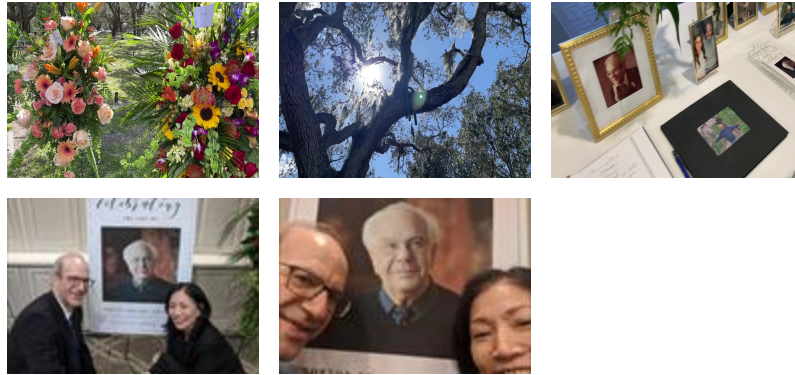

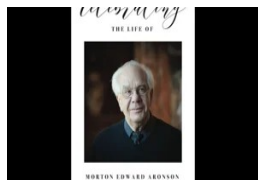
