Murray Seitman, 89, of Sarasota, formerly of New York, died peacefully on November 15th, after a long illness.

Murray and Mimi were married in 1952 and raised their family on Long Island. Murray had a varied career as a CPA/Attorney, as a CFO of a major brokerage firm and as a Professor of Accounting at Adelphi University and Yeshiva University in New York. After moving to Sarasota in 1988, Murray started a new career in volunteerism. He and Mimi also delivered Meals on Wheels for 12 years in Manatee County.
