Nancy Wilkinson, 90, passed away at her home in Sarasota on the evening of Wednesday September 19th. Nancy was born in Orlando in 1928 and was the youngest of three sisters. She attended Wesleyan College in Macon Georgia and then taught school in Winter Garden Florida where she met her future husband. She married Robert Wilkinson in 1953 and they moved to Sarasota in 1957. She was an active member of the First Presbyterian church and a teacher of American history at Sarasota High School for nearly three decades. Nancy enjoyed the outdoors and took her young family on many camping trips and beach outings. After her retirement in the early 90's she built a second home in the Blue Ridge mountains of Virginia where she spent summers with friends enjoying the beautiful scenery and cool mountain air. Her strong faith and love of life instilled in her the courage to survive three bouts with cancer over a 40 year period. Nancy had a quiet inner strength and a loving, accepting personality that endeared her to all whose lives she touched. She is survived by her two sons Rob and Mike, her two daughters-in-law Gerri and Michelle, and her beloved grandsons, Carson and Matthew. A service to celebrate her life will be held at First Presbyterian Church of Sarasota on Wednesday September 26th at 2:00 pm.
