Norman E. Mirrington, 90, a Sarasota resident for the last 33 years, died suddenly at home on Monday, March 20, 2017.

Norm was born September 24, 1926 in Niagara Falls, New York, where he lived until he relocated to Sarasota in 1984 with his loving wife of almost 60 years, Sonia I. Mirrington. He attended the University of Notre Dame on a full basketball scholarship and received a Bachelor's Degree from that institution in 1949. He also served in the United States Army for two years stationed at Fort Sam Houston, Texas. Norm was employed in several capacities for more than 25 years by the City of Niagara Falls.

Norm loved to spend time with his family and to play golf at Bobby Jones Golf Club. He was a Roman Catholic and had great faith. In addition to his wife Sonia, Norm was survived by his son, Michael E. Mirrington (Karen) of Tampa, Florida and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his parents, Ernest W. Mirrington, Sr. and Irene (Slann) Mirrington, sisters Irene Johnson, Margaret Miller and Vera Dixon and brother Ernest W. Mirrington, Jr.

Norm's wishes were to be cremated. The family will schedule a memorial service at a later time.
