Married to Lois M. Hickman of Middletown, Ohio April 18th, 1959. They had one child, Richard Charles Campbell and one Grand Child...Scott Duncan Campbell, both living in Irving, Texas.

Dick and Lois moved to Bradenton, Florida in 1976. Dick was a loving husband, father and grandfather.

He was a Master Mason, 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason, York Rite Mason, Knight Templar and a member of Sarasota Sahib Shrine.

He was an avid sailor. Held a Coast Guard Captain's license and was past commander of Flotilla 83 in the Coast Guard Aux.

Worked as maintenance mechanic at Tropicana in Bradenton from 1976 until retiring in 1989.

He was a prolific artist working in various mediums. Most of his works are in private collections in the US and abroad. He worked in the fields of Display Art and design in and around Cincinnati, Ohio He was special effects designer for King Island Amusement Park at Mason, Ohio.

He is survived by his wife, Lois and his son Rick and grandson Scott.
