FARLEY, Richard K., 78, a retired publishing executive, died Feb. 29 at Sarasota Memorial Hospital. Born in New York City, he grew up in Morristown NJ and lived in New York City and Stuyvesant NY, before relocating to Sarasota in 2016.

Richard loved the Sarasota arts scene, especially its concerts and theater. He was an avid traveler, reader and pianist. He belonged to a bowling league and was an active volunteer in local politics and served in the US military.

Before retiring, Richard was president of North American operations for Marshall Cavendish Ltd. After graduating from Catholic University, Richard earned a Masters in Fine Arts from the University of Georgia and an MBA from New York University.

His husband, Matthew Locricchio, predeceased him in 2019.

Survivors include his brothers John of Morristown NJ, Vincent of Norwalk CT, and a sister, Margaret Steele of Norwalk CT. He also leaves two nieces, a nephew and many beloved friends.
