



Robert "Bob" Ray Ridgway

September 12, 1935 - October 15, 2023

Robert "Bob" Ray Ridgway passed away from cardiac arrest on October 15, 2023, at the age of 88, in Sarasota, FL. His battle with chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL) in recent years took its toll, but he would always welcome and greet his family and friends with a smile.

Born on September 12, 1935, he was the son of the late Clifton Ridgway and Vivian Ridgway (Burch). He is preceded in death by his parents and his brother Clifton Ridgway Jr.

Bob is survived by his High School sweetheart, Beverly (Granchi) Ridgway. They were married for 66 years. Together, they had four wonderful children: David married to Sandy; Paul, married to Jodie; Nicolette "Nicki", married to Tom Gawlowski; and Jon, married to Heather. Bob leaves behind 11 grandchildren, five great grandchildren and his brother George Burch, who is married to Joy.

Bob grew up in Canton, OH and was a swimmer at Lehman High School. He served in the Army as a paratrooper and was honorably discharged in 1956 with a rank of Sergeant. After the military, Bob worked as a Plant Manager for RCA, Electron, and Bundy Tubing. During the first part of his career, Bob and Beverly lived in Ohio, Indiana, Michigan, and Georgia, finally settling in Florida in the early 1990s. In 1992, Bob, and his eldest son opened a MAACO in

Sarasota, FL. After seven successful years, they sold the business, and he retired in 1999.

Bob was very active and enjoyed bowling, golfing, and playing bridge with friends. He was also an avid reader, traveler, and could always be found on football Saturdays watching his beloved Buckeyes.

A public memorial service at the Sarasota National Cemetery is scheduled for Thursday, October 19th at 1:30 p.m. Sarasota National Cemetery is located at 9810 State Rd 72, Sarasota, FL 34241.
