Devoted husband and family man, avid sailor, business executive and army veteran Robert Emmet Dailey of Osprey, Florida died peacefully surrounded by his family. He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Louise Schaefer Dailey and six children Mark (Patricia, deceased), Sheila Rohrer (Henry), Robert Jr. (Suzanne), Thomas (Kathryn), Bibiana Koh (Lee Peterson), and Bryan (Lisa); he was blessed with 19 loving grandchildren. He was pre-deceased by his daughter, Misty.

Mr. Dailey was a senior executive at Xerox Corporation and served as head of investor relations as the firm rose to prominence. Previously, he was a senior finance executive with Stromberg Carlson. He served as an agent in the Counter Intelligence Corps of the U.S. Army.

He graduated from Cornell University in 1953 and was active in alumni groups. He earned a MBA from the University of Rochester.
