Robert John "Bob" Labriola, 89, of Westminster Point Pleasant (Bradenton, Florida) passed away on July 9, 2019. He was born in Altoona PA to Filomena and Antonio Labriola.

He was drafted into the U.S. Army and was posted to Europe during the Korean Conflict. He earned Bachelors, Masters, and Doctoral degrees from The Pennsylvania State University. He enjoyed a long and distinguished career as an educator, first as an elementary school teacher, later as supervisor of student teachers, and for 30 years at Millersville University in Lancaster County, PA where he spearheaded innovative teaching and learning centers and programs ranging from early childhood to adult education. Dr. Labriola had been Dean of Graduate Studies and Extended Programs, Emeritus since 1999.

In his spare time, Bob was an active member of St. John Episcopal Church (York, PA) and enjoyed trips to the Delaware shore and Florida. A staunch Democrat, he followed national politics through daily newspapers and television. After retirement, he and his wife relocated to Sarasota, FL where they enjoyed a new home, long walks, and favorite Italian and seafood restaurants.

Bob will be lovingly remembered by his wife of 59 years, Joan; daughter Jean L. Scholz [Karl W. "Bill"], son Robert J. Labriola Jr. [Sheila]; granddaughters Emily and Sarah; grandson Daniel; and four great-grandchildren.
