Ronald Noel Hendrick was born on November 4, 1938, in Clearwater, FL, and passed away peacefully at home on April 10, 2025, at the age of 86. Known to many as Ronn, he was a devoted husband to Eileen for 56 years and a loving father of five.

A proud Marine and a man of Catholic faith, Ronn lived a life of service, hard work, and humor. He had an entrepreneurial spirit, running a variety of businesses over the years—from catering trucks to a gas station with a sandwich shop to cab driving. In recent years, he could be found happily bagging groceries at Publix, a job he sometimes said was his favorite of all.

Ronn was beloved for his quick wit and memorable catchphrases, including “you can’t improve on perfection,” “hey big guy,” “I’ll see you when I see you,” and his signature response to how he was doing: “Well, I’m overrated.”

He was also known for his “yellow pad prayers,” written in pencil with a mix of capital and lowercase letters, creative spelling, and patriotic intentions. Ever generous, he always carried a pocketful of crisp \$1 bills to dole out to his kids and grandkids.

He was fiercely proud of his family and is survived by his beloved wife of 56 years, Eileen Hendrick (née Hayes), and their five children: U.S. Army

Command Sergeant Major Raymond Hendrick (Christina Castillo); Neil Hendrick, Glenn Hendrick, Gary Hendrick (Fiona Karran), and Jeannie Hendrick-Perales (Daniel Perales) as well as many lifelong family friends and surrogate children including, Yolonda Youngs, Virginia Shearer & Arkady Medovy & Christian Gonsalves

Above all, Ronn took the greatest pride in his grandchildren: Isajah Wilson, Ajna Rain Wilson, Kique Perales, and Luci Perales. He is also survived by his sisters, Janet Holman of Alaska and Rachel Wray of High Springs, FL, and many beloved nieces and nephews.
