



Roy S. Good

December 13, 1924 - May 27, 2026

Roy S. Good died peacefully at his home in Sarasota, Florida on May 27, 2026. Born on December 13, 1924, in Cleveland, Ohio, he served as a Survey and Instrument Man in the 282nd Field Artillery Battalion of the United States Army during World War II. After his return he completed his B.B.A. and M.B.A degrees at Western Reserve University. As a CPA he worked in public accounting at Touche, Ross, Bailey & Smart for nine years before moving to American Motors in 1961. He was promoted to Assistant Controller - Administration in 1963, responsible for the tax department. In this role he was the initiator of Public Law 90-255 (H.R. 4765), which led to American Motors receiving over \$25.5 million in tax rebates in 1968, a year when the company was losing lots of money. He left AMC for Chrysler Corporation where he worked in employee benefits. After Chrysler, he served as Vice President of the International Consulting Group at Alexander & Alexander. He moved to the Sarasota area after retirement, where he lived for over 30 years.

Roy is survived by his daughter, Jeri Dansky; his son, Michael Good; his daughter-in-law, JoAnn Close; his nephews Scott Dansky (John Dawson), Larry Dansky (Kathryn), and Lory Dansky (Doris Conn); and his grand- and great-grand-nephews and nieces. He was predeceased by his sister Amy Dansky, his brother-in-law Harry Dansky; and his wives Julia Good and Wendy Good. The family thanks Nereida Ponce and her team for the fabulous care he received over the past three years.

Funeral services will be Monday, June 1 at 11:00 am at Temple Beth Shalom Cemetery in Sarasota.
