Roy Kaplan, beloved husband of wife Caryl for 36 years passed gently on January 4, 2017.

Roy was born on October 7, 1934, to Tania and Samuel in Los Angeles, California. He attended Hamilton High School and upon graduating joined the U.S. Navy where he honorably served his country. After his service, Roy returned to his hometown of Los Angeles, married Lore, and became father to his two children Kathi and Richard.

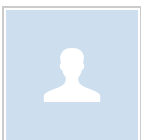
