



Stan Raymond Sr.

May 20, 1919 - January 28, 2016

Stan was born to Sophia and Henry Raymond in Chicago, Illinois.

Stan Raymond was a former Georgia sportscaster, owner and president of a group of radio stations, and was inducted into the Georgia Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame in 2005. Stan started his career in the mailroom of the NBC station in Chicago. He then became a news and sports announcer for NBC in Hannibal, MO at KHMO. From there he went to Charleston, SC, working at WTMA, and on to Atlanta, where he announced the University of Georgia football games for two years. He continued to do a nightly sports show, interviewing sports and entertainment celebrities such as Jack Dempsey, Ted Williams, Bob Hope, Walt Disney, Babe Ruth, Dick Van Dyke, Ted Turner and many others. He started Radio Station WAOK in Atlanta, which became the top R & B station in the market. After ten years, he sold the station and remained as president for another ten years as well as running a group of stations for the new owner. In 1980 he started his own company, STAN RAYMOND & ASSOCIATES, INC. Brokers and Consultants which was successful in many radio and television station transactions over the years, to which he coined the phrase "Now that's a Helluvadeal"!

Stan Raymond is survived by his wife of 37 years, Nancy, his son Stan, Jr. (Kay), his daughter Stephanie Ferry (Gene)(Their mother was former wife, the late Dorothy Styers), his grandchildren Rex Raymond (Merry Beth), Katrina

Moseley (Bryan), Kandace Pritchett (Josh), Kathleen Raymond, Alex Ferry, and Matthew Ferry, his great-grandchildren Trey Raymond, Mollie Raymond, Emilee Moseley, Kayleigh Pritchett and Keira Pritchett.
