Theodore C. "Ted" Geier passed away peacefully at his home in Sarasota, FL on Friday, May 24, 2024. He was 94 years old. Ted is survived by his daughter, son-in-law and two grandchildren. He was predeceased by his wife of 58 years, Joan Hock Geier.
