



Thomas M. Chrapowicki

June 16, 1944 - January 14, 2021

Thomas (“Tom” or “Chap”) M. Chrapowicki, a retired US Postal Worker and longtime resident of Sarasota, died January 14 at Doctor’s Hospital at the age of 76 after his longtime battle with heart disease.
