Age 71, of Sarasota, FL. Thomas (Tom) Crimmins, loving husband, father, brother, and friend passed away unexpectedly November 10, 2022. Tom was born July 15, 1951, in Pittsburgh, PA., the seventh of nine children of Catherine Lucile O'Malley Crimmins and John Michael Crimmins, Sr. He grew up in the Squirrel Hill neighborhood attending St. Bede School and Central Catholic High School. He graduated from John Carroll University in Cleveland, Ohio where he established many life-long friendships. His family vacationed in the summer on Lake Erie at Van Buren Point, NY., where he returned throughout his life as a place of memory, celebration, and conviviality.

Tom worked his college summers at Cedar Point Amusement Park, where he met his future wife, Kathleen Flynn. They were married November 30, 1974. They shared a life together moving as Tom's sales career advanced from Chicago to Ann Arbor, St. Augustine, Atlanta, and finally Sarasota where they retired.
