Thomas M. Fultz, age 91 passed away on June 28th. He was born August 12th, 1926 in Lewistown, Pennsylvania. He moved to Meadville, PA in 1935 and became an Airforce Cadet at age 16. He actively served in WW11 as SGT. in the United States Army Air Forces as a B-29 tail gunner. Using the GI Bill, he attended Bryant Stratton in Buffalo, New York where he earned an AA degree. Tom moved to Sarasota, FL with his family in 1962. He worked for EMR for 26 years, retiring in 1988 as Contract Administrator. He was a lifetime member of the Masonic Lodge.
