



Thomas Bernard Kilduff

July 4, 1932 - January 9, 2017

Thomas 'Tom' Kilduff of Siesta Key, Florida, formerly of Yonkers, New York, passed away peacefully on January 9, 2017 at the age of 84 after a short illness.

Tom was born on July 4, 1932 in Yonkers, New York to Rose Ellen 'Nellie' (Keon) and Patrick Kilduff. He attended Commerce High School and upon graduation (1951) joined the US Air Force and served in the Korean War. Tom was a member of the Dock Builders Local 1456 in NYC, and the Yonkers Motor Cycle Club.
