Timothy "Tim" Jessup died peacefully while at Hospice in Bradenton Florida on 18 June 2016 after succumbing to a rapid form of cancer at the age of 52.

Tim is survived by his; wife, Cindy; two (2) step daughters, Cheyenne Kuyper and Caley Hopkins; Eight (8) brothers and sisters, James & Debi, Maryellen & Mike {Keane}, Jean Ann, Lawrence & Carolann, Thomas, Michael, Paul and Patricia & Sean {McCann} as well a 17 nieces and nephews.

Tim was born on 8 April 1964 in Smithtown NY to James and Alice Jessup. He was a graduate of Ward Melville HS in Setauket NY in 1982 and was an Army Veteran. Upon leaving the Army Tim settled in Florida in 1990 and worked for Asplundh Tree where he was a regional supervisor for 25 years.

Tim was an accomplished Athlete excelling in softball and weight training. He loved the Dallas Cowboys and everything Cowboy related, often traveling to Dallas for multiple games during a season. He was a generous individual who loved to be amongst his family and friends and who was passionate about Veteran affairs. Tim had a great sense of humor and was never afraid to laugh at himself first. To be around him was usually a mix of sharp wit and satire, if you were not prepared you could easily have to bear the brunt of the conversation. He was an active and dedicated member of the Wounded Warrior project.
