



## Vytas "Mac" Maceikonis

October 16, 1938 - December 22, 2019

Mac was born in Lithuania. He fled Lithuania with his partial family in 1944 as the Russian troops advanced into Germany. They walked most of the way to South Germany where they stayed in a displaced person camp until 1949, when they left Europe for New Jersey.

After high school and working, Vytas was drafted into the US Army. He was stationed in Germany where he met his future wife Gerda. Thanks to the GI bill, Vytas received a degree in economics from Rutgers Newark, while working full time at Exxon. He and Gerda married in 1965 in New Jersey and have one son Kurt who lives in Sarasota.

After selling their business in New Jersey, they moved to Longboat Key in 1999. Vytas and Gerda have resided at Plymouth Harbor since 2013.

Vytas will be buried at the Sarasota National Cemetery, at 2:00pm, on January 9, 2020.
