Walter Kuerschner, 92, died on May 3, 2022, after a long battle with cancer. He was born in New York City on February 24, 1930. He attended Styvesant High School in Manhattan and later graduated from the College of the City of New York where he majored in Electrical Engineering. After graduation, he was employed at the RCA Institute in NYC, where he focused on educational programming in computers.

Walt served in the US Army from 1951 through 1953 during the Korean War. Upon discharge from the Army, he was employed by IBM until he retired in 1988.

Walt married Aglaia “Pat” Bouclis on January 20, 1973. Upon their retirement in 1988, they relocated to Sarasota, Florida. They enjoyed many outdoor activities from playing tennis on Longboat Key to walking the grounds of the Landings and swimming at local beaches. They also enjoyed dancing and dining out with dear friends. Pat died unexpectedly on November 17, 2019.

Walt is survived by Pat’s cousins Basil Economou and Robert and Cathleen D’Amico (nee Ford). He will also be missed by numerous members of his extended family to whom he was lovingly referred to as “Uncle Walt.”
