Mr. Warren Newton Ramsay, 89 years young, of Sarasota, Florida (formerly of Great Neck, New York) died quietly at home with family members present on May 20, 2016 of cancer.

A family man of strong Christian faith, Warren was born in New York in 1926 to Lillian and Charles Ramsay and raised in Jamaica, West Indies along with his sister Elaine and younger brother Basil.
