Wimberly Pearson Cannon of Sarasota, Florida and Brentwood, Tennessee passed away in the early morning hours on March 25, 2016. He is survived by his son Mark E. Cannon and his daughter and son in law, Kimberly and Michael Browder, grandchildren Marques, Nicholas, Pearce, Madison and Hank.
